Year 1	<i>Theme- Out of this World</i> Using different art materials to make a space picture.	<i>Theme-Toys in the Past</i> Study of Andy Warhol and his Toys series. Experimenting with printing to produce own pieces inspired by Warhol's designs.	<i>Theme- Jurassic Forest</i> Children will use a variety of collage materials to make a dinosaur.
Year 2	<i>Theme – Fire! The Great Fire of London</i> Children will make a collage of the great fire of London and use drawing and painting skills to create compositions.	<i>Theme- Fighting Fit</i> Fruit and Vegetable printing. <i>Study of the artist - Cezanne.</i> Exploring still life drawings and paintings. Completing observational drawings in the style of Cezanne.	<i>Theme – 'Oh I do like to be beside the seaside!'</i> Children will be creating seascapes, collages of the seaside using natural materials, sea prints and using paint to create seaside landscapes.
Year 3	<i>Theme- The Romans</i> Creating coin rubbings using different materials.	<i>Drawing real life objects</i> Children will develop an understanding of visual and tactile elements, including: colour, pattern and texture, line and tone, shape, form and space.	<i>Study of the architect- Antoni Gaudi</i> Evaluating the work of Antoni Gaudi and designing and making a tile in the style of Gaudi.
Year 4	<i>Landscape drawings</i> Children will be developing observational skills.	<i>Study of the artist - Henri Rousseau.</i> Children will find out about the life and work of Henri Rousseau. Children will then create their own art work in the style of Rousseau.	<i>Ancient Egyptian art</i> Children will explore art that was completed in the Ancient Egyptian era. They will make a mask towards the end of the unit.
Year 5	<i>European Artists</i> The children explore the work of European artists Anselm Kiefer, Michelangelo, Salvador Dali and Rembrandt, architect Le Corbusier and designer Coco Chanel.	<i>North America</i> The children explore the work of some North American artists and use their works to inspire their own art work.	<i>Seaside</i> Children have the opportunity to explore the work of 'The Seaside' artists Alfred Wallis and Hokusai.
Year 6	<i>Study of the artist- Banksy</i> Children will be taught to develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of arts.	<i>Pointillism</i> Children will study the art form named pointillism. They will learn that pointillism is a painting that is made up entirely of small dots. They will create their own pointillism painting.	<i>Study of the artist – Roy Lichtenstein</i> Children will learn about the American artist who was a leading figure in the visual art movement known as pop art. Children will complete art work in the style of Roy Lichtenstein.
