HOMEWORK TIMETABLE – YEAR 5 & YEAR 6

Please help us to teach your child well by making sure your child completes all homework and returns it to school on the correct day. This will help to practise knowledge learned in school and will allow your child to develop organisational and study skills

The information below acts as a general guide to homework tasks. There might be occasions when teachers feel it is relevant to set a piece of homework over a longer timescale as it requires a more comprehensive study. If that is the case pupils will write a note in their PAL explaining deadlines so that parents are aware when homework is due.

Day	Work to be completed	When this is to be handed in
Monday	Spellings and English task Reading Hand in Maths	Hand in on Friday Please write pages read in the reading record section of your PAL
Tuesday	Science task Reading	Hand in on Friday Please write pages read in the reading record section of your PAL
Wednesday	Maths Reading	Hand in on Monday Please write pages read in the reading record section of your PAL
Thursday	Reading Ask parents to sign your PAL	Please write pages read in the reading record section of your PAL
Friday	Reading Hand in English, Science and PAL	Please write pages read in the reading record section of your child's PAL

We ask parents to read with their child every day for at least 10 minutes to sustain progress. If you are able to read more often than this please do so.

Remember to write all home reading in the 'reading record' section of your child's PAL and to **sign their PAL each week.**
