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Fantastic KS2 Pupil Results

A national breakdown of Key Stage Two results was released earlier this week.

Elmridge's results place it in the top 4% of primary schools nationally for attainment in reading, writing and mathematics and comfortably within the top 20% for progress between Key Stage One and Key Stage Two. This demonstrates that not only are the pupils reaching extremely high standards by the end of Key Stage Two, but that pupils of all academic abilities are making significant strides throughout the same period.

Alongside the outstanding efforts of all the pupils and staff in school, your efforts, as parents/carers, are key in enabling your children to achieve this success. Activities such as supporting with homework, securing regular attendance and support with reading have all played a vital role. Well done to all!
