<p><b>Stories with familiar settings</b> Children read Dogger, Oliver's Vegetables and Fussy Freda, which are familiar stories with predictable phrases and patterned language. They write their own similar stories using a storyboard.</p> <p><b>Labels, lists and captions</b> Looking at examples of labels, lists and captions and their purposes.</p>	<p><b>Number</b> Addition and Subtraction within 10</p> <p><b>Geometry:</b> Shape</p> <p><b>Number</b> Place Value within 20</p>	<p><b>Celebrations</b> We will be learning about light sources and properties of materials including transparent and opaque materials.</p>	<p><b>Programming: Bee-Bots</b> Children are introduced to programming through a Bee-Bot; exploring its functions, creating a video to explain its capabilities, undertaking an unplugged activity, creating a world for Bee-Bot to explore and programming their Bee-Bot to tell a story.</p>	<p>Taught in Autumn 1</p>	<p><b>Why do we have Remembrance Day?</b> We will be learning about Remembrance Day and asking why we have it, what happens on Remembrance Day and why we wear poppies. We will learn about the importance of Remembrance and the vital work of the Royal British Legion.</p>
