

Curriculum covered in Year 3 Autumn 1 Half Term 2021.

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p><u>Poetry</u> Children will use Roger McGough's collection of poems called Poetry Pie to begin recognising different poetic forms and how poets use poetry as a voice to express their own feelings and views.</p> <p><u>Traditional story</u> Children will have a look at the story of Jack and the Bean stalk and rewrite an alternate version from a different character's perspective. They will continue to learn how to use expanded noun phrases to add descriptive detail.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p><u>Place Value and Number</u> Children will learn the value of digits in a 3-digit number and then be able to find 1, 10 and 100 more and less than a given number. They will be comparing and ordering numbers up to 1000 and also counting backwards and forwards in 50s.</p> <p><u>Addition and subtraction</u> The children will learn how to add and subtract multiples of 100. They will learn to add and subtract two 3-digit numbers crossing 10 or 100. They will begin learning how to estimate answers to calculations and to use the inverse to check answers.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p><u>Food and our bodies</u> Children will find out about healthy and balanced diets. They will describe the basic parts of the skeletal system and compare animals with and without skeletons. Children will look at three different types of joints and how bones and muscles help us move.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p><u>Scratch</u> Children will be exploring programming using Scratch. They will be using loops and sound blocks to create music. They will learn how to debug a program and begin to explain how an algorithm works and try replicating it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p><u>Extreme Earth</u> Children will begin by thinking about what is underneath our feet and then learn about the different layers of the earth. They will explore how volcanoes are formed, what causes earthquakes and how these are measured. Finally, they will learn about the causes of tsunamis and tornadoes. Throughout the unit, children will think and discuss how these extreme weathers impact people's lives.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p><u>Let your spirit fly!</u> Musical styles considered in this unit are R&B, Western Classical, Musicals, Motown and Soul. All the learning is focused around: Let Your Spirit Fly. Through games, the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design & Technology</u></p> <p><u>Can you make your own 'light up' sign?</u> Children will begin by investigating and analysing illuminated signs before developing ideas for their own sign. They will select and use tools, equipment and components to make their own sign.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spanish</u></p> <p>Children will learn how to greet others, ask about feelings and introduce themselves.
